Target Affordability and Control Cost Growth

- Mandate affordability as a requirement
- Implement “should cost” based management
- Eliminate redundancy within warfighter portfolios
- Achieve Stable and economical production rates
- Manage program timelines

Incentivize Productivity & Innovation in Industry

- Reward contractors for successful supply chain and indirect expense management
- Increase Use of FPIF contract type (vice CPFF/IF)
- Capitalize on progress payment structures
- Institute a superior supplier incentive program
- Reinvigorate industry’s independent research and development

Promote Real Competition

- Emphasize competitive strategy at each program milestone
- Remove obstacles to competition
 - Allow reasonable time to bid
 - Require non-certified cost and pricing data on single offers
 - Enforce open system architectures and set rules for acquisition of technical data rights
- Increase small business role and opportunities

Improve Tradecraft in Acquisition of Services

- Assign senior managers for acquisition of services
- Adopt uniform services market segmentation (taxonomy)
- Address causes of poor tradecraft
 - Define requirements and prevent creep
 - Conduct market research
- Increase small business participation

Reduce Non-Productive Processes and Bureaucracy

- Reduce frequency of OSD level reviews
- Work with Congress to eliminate low value added statutory requirements
- Reduce the volume and cost of Congressional Reports
- Reduce non-value added requirements imposed on industry
- Align DCMA and DCAA processes to ensure work is complementary
- Increase use of Forward Pricing Rate Recommendations (FRRs) to reduce administrative costs



NAWCTSD 2011 Strategic Thrusts



- **Perfect Navy Working Capital Fund Business Culture**
- **Maintain Schedule for Awarding TSCIII**
- **Accentuate Warfare Center Role in Shaping Simulation Strategy for the Navy**
 - Navy/USMC looking to TSD as technical “conscience” as decisions on simulation investments are pursued to offset fuel costs/FLE/etc (NASMP)
- **Validation Against Requirement coupled with Training Effectiveness Evaluations**
 - Growth of T&E competency within TSD and the role of T&E in programs
- **Accelerate Acquisition Timelines AND Quality**
 - Strong accountability for acquisition planning - honor customer expectations
 - RFPs within MACs tailored to most relevant information
 - “IPT”-manship

- **WIGS – Wildly Important Goals**
 - Mentorship – “iMentor.....Do you?”
 - Acquisition Support Group Standup
 - NWCF Transition and Targets

- **Deepen STEM Partnerships With Industry and Academia**

 - EPAs with Orange and Seminole
